Entries limited to 4 (four) dogs in the TD test and 4 (four) dogs in the TDX Test.

Per AKC Tracking Regulations Chapter 1, Section 13, other breeds may compete but English Cocker Spaniels without tracking titles will be given preference, followed by English Cocker Spaniels with tracking titles, then other breeds without tracking titles and finally, other breeds with tracking titles. If the limit for entries in one test is not reached and the limit for entries in the other test has been exceeded, the number of tracks may be exchanged up to the day of plotting, not to exceed the limits set in Chapter 1, Section 15 of the Tracking Regulations.

Entries close Wednesday, April 25, 2018 at 5:00 pm at the home of the test secretary, after which time entries cannot be accepted, altered or substituted.

CLOSING DATE WEDNESDAY, APRIL 25, 2018 AT 5:00 PM central time at the home of the Test Secretary.

Do not send entries by any method requiring a signature for delivery. Faxes, email, credit card, etc. entries will not be accepted. Entries must be made on official AKC entry forms. All cancellations must be made in writing, and received prior to the closing date and time.

ENTRY DRAWING - will be held the same evening at 8:00 pm at the home of the test secretary, 8890 Dunlap Ave, Lexington, MN 55014. Draw order will be acknowledged by email and/or telephone and by mail with draw number and directions to the site. Entry fees will be refunded for a dog withdrawn after the closing date, provided an alternate runs in its place. Notice of withdrawal must be in writing, including dog's name and number. Non-participating alternates' fees will be returned after the test.

BITCHES IN SEASON will be allowed to participate. They will be assigned the last track(s). Please report to the Test Secretary **before** the drawing for track order on the morning of the test, and keep your bitch in your vehicle until time to run her track.

INCLEMENT WEATHER In the event of extreme weather conditions the Club may take such action as necessary to protect the health and safety of the dogs, handlers and judges, including postponement or cancellation of the test.

LOCATION: Kinnickinnic State Park is located in Northwestern Wisconsin near River Falls, WI. This park is part of the Wisconsin State Park System. Entrance requires a Wisconsin State Park Annual Sticker (\$28.00 WI resident, \$38.00 non-resident) or payment of a daily use fee (\$8.00 WI/\$11.00 non-resident). There is a self-payment station near the entrance. (The rangers do check often!). The test site is approximately 104 miles from the National Specialty site in St. Cloud MN, 52 miles from the Agility venue, and 82 miles from the Working Dog and Hunt Test grounds.

Turn right and go about 0.2 miles; the park entrance will be on your left. **From U.S. Highway 10,** go about 1.2 miles east of Prescott, go north on State Highway 29 about 1.2 miles to County Highway F. Turn left (north) onto County Highway F and go 5.2 miles to Cedar View Road (820th Avenue). Turn left and go about 0.2 miles; the park entrance will be on your left. Geographic coordinates are 44° 50' 14.10" N, 92° 44' 7.31" W. The test draw site is at the St Croix Picnic Area at the very end of the park's road.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event, and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of the dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury, or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
